## The MASCA Logo

This is a symbolic representation of two distant places, oceans apart, yet brought close by a common goal.

The nugget-shaped outline is the map of the province of Pampanga in the Philippines and represents our ethnic origin. The shell (kabibi), points to the town of Macabebe. The state map with a star represents Southern California where the organization is based.

The acronym 'MASCA' between the two maps represent the organization's social role as a catalyst in promoting the cultural and religious heritage of its members. The letters M A S C A penned in a series of steps stand for our service role as a 'staircase' in assisting our 'kabalens' (townmates) here and most especially back home in the pursuit of their dreams.

Finally, the year 1979, emphasizes the longevity and resiliency of our organization and reminds future leaders of our legacy.
